

Visitor Center

- Open 9:00 am to 4:00 pm daily during the warmer months and week-ends all year.
- Educational wildlife exhibits and brochures.
- Gift shop operated by Coastal Wildlife Refuge Society to benefit Refuge programs.
- Refuge volunteers available to answer questions and provide information.

Photoblind available during daylight hours.

North Pond Wildlife Trail

- Half-mile.
- Fully disabled accessible.
- Overlooks, towers, and spotting scopes.
- Wheelchair available for loan.
- Bicycles prohibited.

More energetic visitors may choose to walk or bicycle the four miles of service road around North Pond and back along NC 12.

Regulations

- Daylight use only. (Refuge closed from sunset to sunrise)
- Do not enter closed areas.
- Pets on leash only.
- No pets allowed on west side of NC 12 (except parking areas).
- Drive on designated roadways (no vehicles on beach).
- Feeding of wildlife is prohibited.
- Littering, camping, hunting, firearms, fires, fireworks, and metal detectors are prohibited.
- Fishing, boating, swimming, and wading in ponds are prohibited.
